





- To inculcate productivity consciousness through promotion of productivity concept at macro and micro levels of economy

- To increase efficiency in business management and industrial operations, by providing management consultancy and technical assistance


Objectives

India Productivity Initiatives



- To improve productivity and to enable the productivity movement to gain momentum; 1966 and 1982 had been designated as Productivity Years.
- National Skill Development Initiative launched by the Government of India
- Exit policy will be put in place to promote productivity
- Manufacturing management will be given a focused attention as it will facilitate improvement of productivity, quality and competitiveness of manufacturing enterprise

Malaysia Productivity Initiatives



- Unlocking the potential of productivity has been considered as an important game changer in 11th Malaysian Plan.
- Why is productivity important for Malaysia
 - Greater emphasis has to be put on enhancing productivity to achieve a more sustainable, inclusive, and high rate of economic growth.
- What will success look like
 - Labor productivity is targeted to rise by 3.7% per annum to RM 92,300 in 2020 from RM 77,100 in 2015.
 - Sectors' growth will accelerate due to improvements in productivity
- How will this be achieved
 - Malaysia's approach to productivity will shift from primarily Government-driven initiatives at the national level to targeted actions across the public sector, industry players, and individual enterprises.
